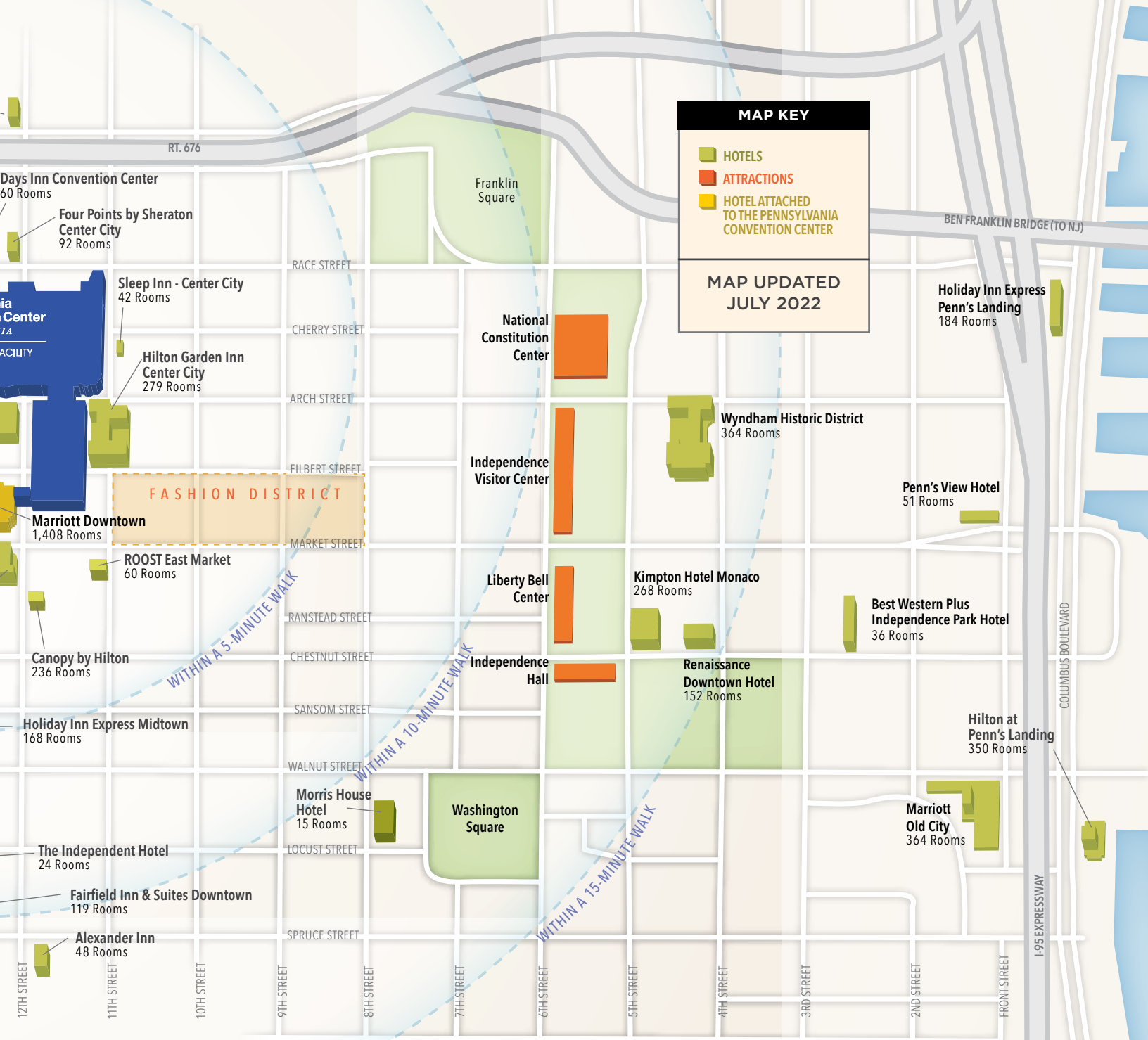


UNIVERSITY CITY, 7-MINUTE DRIVE
